
The MentorAbility Model

The three primary participants in the MentorAbility initiative include: mentee, mentor, and mentorship facilitator.



Mentor

An employer, manager, or professional who has an interest in sharing industry knowledge and career experience.

Mentee

A job seeker who has an interest in exploring specific industries, career pathways, and job options.

Mentorship Facilitator

An employment professional who facilitates an engaging mentorship experience by ensuring best fit, sharing relevant mentor information and resources, and guiding discussion around workplace disability-inclusion practices.

While mentorship is the core component of MentorAbility, the initiative also integrates events, awareness-building, and research.





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
