## **Supported Employment Sets Workers and Employers Up for Success**

One in five workers in Canada experiences some type of disability (Statistics Canada). Disability can include physical, neurological, developmental, intellectual, or cognitive disability, mental health challenges (like depression and anxiety), neurodivergence (such as autism, ADHD, and dyslexia), and substance use disorder.

Supported employment recognizes the skill, talent, experience, and contributions that employees who experience disability bring to the Canadian workforce. It also acknowledges the challenges employers can face when recruiting and employing workers experiencing disability. Supported employment is a successful, individualized, and flexible model that matches job seekers with employers and facilitates successful employment relationships for both.

The conference theme, **Working Together**, emphasizes the importance of collaboration—among service providers, workers, employers, and community organizations—to create successful employment stories.

Through an innovative collaborative approach, the cooperative manages and oversees the delivery of employment services via its member agencies throughout New Brunswick.

AvenueNB ensures both individuals with disabilities and employers have equitable access to employment services and supports. By fostering collaboration, promoting professional development, building partnerships, and maintaining accountability, avenueNB is driving meaningful change in the province's employment landscape.
